**Recommendation**: Approve Coherent Governance Policy Operational Expectations 7 (OE-7) – Asset Protection - Monitoring Report.

<u>Background/Rationale</u>: The Board has directed the Superintendent to provide Monitoring Reports on a regular schedule at open session Board meetings. Monitoring determines the degree to which Board policies are being met. This report is designed to share progress toward the results the Board expects to see for the school system, as well as the effectiveness of the system's operations. This report, therefore, is a review of the organization's performance as it relates to Operational Expectations 7 – Asset Protection.

The report includes the following information:

- x The policy.
- x The Superintendent's certification.
- x Reasonable Interpretation of the policy.
- x Evidence of compliance.

**Division:** Superintendent's Office

After the Board meets in open session to discuss the report, two additional sections of the report will be completed by the Board chair:

- x Disposition of the Board. (The policy is found by the Board to be "in compliance," "in compliance with exceptions," or "not in compliance.")
- x Comments.

The Board will discuss the data and conclusions from the Monitoring Report in open session. At the end of the discussion, the Board will vote as to whether it will accept the report, as presented, as evidence of reasonable interpretation and reasonable progress toward achieving the Board's policy. The Board will determine whether the policy is "in compliance," "in compliance with exceptions," or "not in compliance." If the policy is found to be "in compliance with exceptions," or "not in compliance," the Board has the option to direct the Superintendent to correct the non-compliance indicators and report back to the Board at a time outside the regular monitoring schedule.
