

SCUSD vs UC/CSU Graduation Requirements

To qualify for UC/CSU admissions, students must take courses that have been approved by the Regents of the UC as meeting their requirements and must be passed with a grade of **C** or better). Courses that receive a grade of **F** do not earn any credits. Courses not completed with a passing grade of a **C** or better must be retaken to earn credit toward college admission.
